





This guide will show you how to quickly and easily create a Make Up ReadBasix assessment for students with rushed and missing scores using the advanced filters.




**2** Click ReadBasix as if you were creating a normal test.




3 Name the assessment.


Select the subtests you want to be included in the make up assessment. It is 4 recommended to select all subtests that students have previously completed.




5 Click 'Advanced student filters'





6 Click 'Rushed' This will add all students that rushed through one or more of the selected subtests.




Click 'Unreliable/missing' This will add all students that did not answer enough questions for one or more of the selected subtests.









## 10 Click 'Groups'




Click 'Add all' Only students who need to take a subtest are added to the this test. It is best to add all so you do not miss students.




## 12 Click 'Done'




## 13 Click 'Launch Now'
