





Find the student you need to set accommodations for and click the student button to open the drop-down menu.


There are four accommodations available in Capti: extended time, changing font, changing color theme or contrast for visually impaired students, and disabling keyboard shortcuts. Let's review each setting in more detail.






Alert! The reading efficiency subtest is not affected by timing accommodations.


You can set extended time for the assessment. The options are Standard, 1.5x and 2.0x time.




You can change the text font to IBM Plex Sans, Georgia, Balsamiq Sans, or Open Dyslexic. We recommend setting the font to Open Dyslexic for students with dyslexia or visual impairments.



7 The next setting is color theme, the default color theme is set to Light, but you can change it to Dark, Dark Contrast, or Sepia.



You can disable keyboard shortcuts to prevent students from answering questions with their keyboard and require them to use the mouse instead. This setting is primarily intended for students using screen readers and is generally not recommended for others.





Alert! Disable shortcuts is not recommended for most users. Please be mindful selecting this setting.
